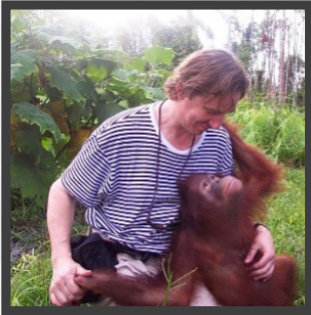

Types of gifts you can leave

Residuary gift:

A residuary legacy is a gift of a percentage of the remainder of your estate after all your other wishes have been fulfilled

and expenses met. Because the value of your gift will rise with inflation, it will be worth as much to us tomorrow as it is today.

Specific gift:

A specific legacy is a gift of a specific item of value. For example, a painting or a property.



SUGGESTED WORDING FOR YOUR WILL

Donate the residue of your estate:

"I give and bequeath (free of all duties) the rest and residue of my estate to Borneo Orangutan Survival (BOS) New Zealand Trust (CC61424), in aid of that charity and for its general purposes, with the written acknowledgment of Borneo Orangutan Survival (BOS) New Zealand Trust to be accepted by my executors as a full and complete discharge."

Donate a percentage of your estate (residuary gift)

"I give and bequeath (free of all duties) a percentage of OR the whole of the residue of my estate to Borneo Orangutan Survival (BOS) New Zealand Trust (CC61424) in aid of that charity and for its general purposes, with the written acknowledgement of Borneo Orangutan Survival (BOS) New Zealand Trust to be accepted by my executors as a full and complete discharge."

Donate a specific sum and/or items from my estate (a pecuniary gift):

"I give to Borneo Orangutan Survival (BOS) New Zealand Trust (CC61424), (free of all duties) the sum of \$.... in aid of that charity and for its general purposes, with the written acknowledgement of Borneo Orangutan Survival (BOS) New Zealand Trust to be accepted by my executors as a full and complete discharge."

Pecuniary gift:

A pecuniary legacy is a gift of a specific amount of money.
For example,
\$10,000.
